



## Theatre Denton Theatre School COVID-19 Safety Protocols

We are pleased to introduce the safety procedures for all classes, rehearsals, and performances.  
Updated 11/5/21 to reflect current CDC guidelines pertaining to students.

- Staff, Volunteers, Participants, and Patrons are asked to self-screen\* before attending any classes, rehearsals, and/or performances.
- Prior to admission, Staff, Volunteers, and Participants will have their temperature taken with a touchless thermometer. Anyone with a fever of 100.0 or above will not be admitted.
- For the protection of the Students and Staff, all Staff, Volunteers, Participants, and Patrons must wear a face mask properly at all times. Those arriving without a mask must acquire one before entering or will not be admitted.
- Students must provide their own acceptably protective face mask. Consistent with CDC recommendations, only cloth or disposable surgical-type masks that fit snugly to the face will be allowed. Shields (worn without a mask) and respirator masks (with a vent valve) are not considered adequate protection.

### TECHNICAL REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES

- Students should arrive at the theatre already in base costume and make-up and ready to take the stage.
- Face masks must be worn at all times in the theatre, onstage, backstage, and in dressing rooms.
- ONLY required personnel may be admitted backstage during technical rehearsals and performances.

#### \*Self-screening

Prior to coming to classes, rehearsals, or performances, assess for any of the following signs or symptoms:

- Fever (greater than 100°F)
- Chills
- Unexplained new or worsening cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Unexplained muscle or body aches
- Unexplained sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Unexplained headache
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Unexplained congestion or runny nose
- Close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19
